Based on ages and records found, these are most likely the descendants of Bernardina, one of two Indian servants identified in the below census:

1750 – NM, Villa de Albuquerque

No other information has been found for Bernardina, and she was not identified in any of the wills for the early Gurulé families.

Note → each generation is indented...thus Bernardina is the mother for all children with #1 by their name. Then, Maria Antonia Gurulé and Jose Duran y Chavez are parents of children with #2 by their name, etc.
